All persons owning or occupying any lot or tract of land in the city shall keep the weeds, high grass and other vegetation growing on such property cut and removed. Whenever such weeds, high grass and other vegetation shall attain the height of 12 inches, it shall be deemed a public nuisance.

The Chief of Police shall give a hearing after 10 days' notice thereof, either personally or by US Mail to the owner or owners, or their agents, or by posting such notice on the premises, thereupon, the Chief of Police may declare the weeds, high grass or other vegetation to be a nuisance and order the same to be abated within 5 days

In case the weeds, high grass or other vegetation are not cut down and removed within the 5 days, the Chief of Police shall have the weeds, high grass or other vegetation cut down and removed and shall certify the cost to be billed to you.

Let's work together and clean up Diamond. If you have any large items please contact Allied Waste at 800-431-1507 to schedule a pickup. They will take one large item a week.
