The City is pleased to announce that it has perceived final approval for the Community Development Block Grant. The funding is now in place for the repairs to the

Waste Water Lagoons. The bidding process will take approximately four to five weeks and then a contractor will be chosen. With the Winter months quickly approaching, and the mandatory time for bids, it will be to risky to start the project. Council with the advise of the engineer and the approval of DNR, has decided to wait until late Spring before the project will begin. The City will continue to work on the inflow problems and monitor the lagoons.

GARDEN METER WARNING

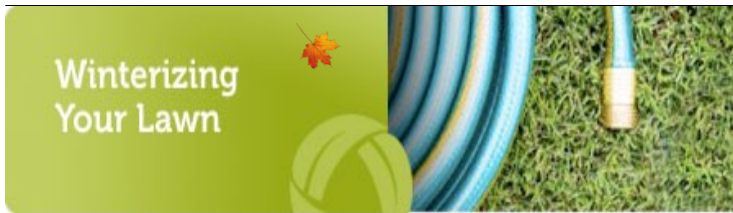


If you purchased a garden meter, as temperatures begin to fall it is important to remove your meter before they have a chance to

Drain them and let them dry completely before storing inside for the winter.
