They must do this before March 24, 2023.

The Mayor gave a brief review of the City of Joplin Regionalization plans for the sewer system. The Mayor and Project Manager/Waster Water Superintendent attended the meeting and said there was a discussion of a feasibility study for the sewer system and there would be no cost to the City of Diamond.
